 - We are going to talk about “Why Buckle Up”

- It's not OK to not use a seatbelt. You can get hurt very badly.
- When you are travelling at a speed of 100 km per hour and you are involved in a motor vehicle collision, you will still be travelling at 100 km per hour
- That means that if you are not **buckled up** your body will be thrown against the windshield and you will experience the windshield taste test

- But that's not all
 - After you have been thrown through the windshield, your body is ejected into the pavement, a ditch, or a nearby field
 - It doesn't mean that you will die but you will be badly injured and likely end up with permanent injuries.
 - You might end up in a wheel chair for the rest of your life, suffer from brain damage, or even be on life support
